Capture Nature Program Description	The Friends' <i>Capture Nature</i> Photography Contest invites park users to engage in Fish Creek Provincial Park using their creativity and photographic skill as they try to capture one of the winning park images of the year. Funds raised through <i>Capture Nature</i> registration contribute to our overall education and stewardship initiatives in the park.
Overall Role of Juror	To support Friends' staff in the coordination and delivery of <i>Capture Nature</i> to the public.
Desired Outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To support the Friends in engaging the public in a fun and rewarding program • To help encourage park use and recreational activities in the park • To directly contribute to the financial sustainability of the Friends
Tasks & Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend volunteer orientation and final adjudication at the end of the contest • From your own home or other remote location, work independently to review and organize photo submissions and submit your choices for winning photographs to Supervisor through Google Docs • Potentially communicate with participants via email throughout the contest regarding questions or technical support needed to submit photos • Potentially communicate with schools and local business with the goal of increasing public awareness and participation in the program • Log volunteer hours for independent work time using <i>MyImpact</i> • Communicate with Supervisor regarding any issues that arise during the contest • Support Friends' staff in program development via ongoing feedback based on your volunteer experience
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete a Friends of Fish Creek Volunteer Agreement • Professional experience in photography is preferred (or a high level of personal experience) • Be a dependable team player, with an objective eye for photographic quality • Must have computer/internet skills (knowledge of Google Docs is helpful)
Time Commitment	Estimated 2-4 hours independent time/month during the contest (May 1 to July 31), 2-hrs each for volunteer orientation (April) and final adjudication meeting in (August)
Training Provided	Friends of Fish Creek orientation
Evaluation	Feedback will be provided throughout your volunteer role. Volunteers will also be invited to complete an end-of-season Volunteer Experience Survey to provide feedback to the organization.
