Overall Role of Tour Assistants To support Friends' Tour Guides and ensure that tours are well-coordinated and safely run. **Desired Outcomes** Increased community engagement through a variety of different tour topics and opportunities Increased public participation in tour programming Well organized and efficiently run programs Tasks and Responsibilities Sign up for volunteer shifts using MyImpact Participate in the completion/review of the First and Last Five Minutes forms for each Professionally represent the Friends of Fish Creek during programs Greet participants, facilitate registration and collect drop-in fees Support Tour Guide in the event of an emergency to ensure tour participants are safe Submit paperwork and fees to Supervisor at the end of each tour Provide feedback to Supervisor regarding issues, concerns or program logistics Bring personal water, sunscreen and hat and dress for the weather and trail conditions Requirements Complete a Friends of Fish Creek Volunteer Agreement Clear Police Information and Vulnerable Sector Checks (first year Assistants only) Carry fully-charged personal cell phone Mandatory completion of Tour Assistant volunteer training Friendly and professional interpersonal skills Ability to work with Friends' staff, other volunteers and the public Basic computer/internet literacy and working email account Time Commitment A minimum of two 2-hour shifts each month from May to October Training Mandatory Tour Assistant Program volunteer training held in April with mentor shifts scheduled at the beginning of the season with experienced volunteers. Evaluation Ongoing.
